Dr. Mick Elliott is the Secretary of Greater Midland Emergency Physicians (GMEP), a private physician group that employs and contracts board certified Emergency Medicine physicians and specialty trained advanced practice providers for the purpose of staffing emergency departments.

GMEP was founded and began operations in December 2016. Since its inception, GMEP has grown from a single emergency department contract to four emergency departments. These include MyMichigan Medical Centers in Alma, Mt. Pleasant, West Branch, and Alpena, Michigan.

Dr. Elliott joined GMEP in 2018, after spending 10 years practicing Emergency Medicine in Washington state, and is currently the Medical Director for the Emergency Department at MyMichigan Medical Center-Mt. Pleasant. He remains a practicing Emergency Physician, working alongside the GMEP team at all 4 emergency departments that GMEP serves.

He has an undergraduate degree in Exercise Physiology from University of Southern California in Los Angeles, CA and earned his Doctor of Medicine degree from Lewis Katz School of Medicine at Temple University in Philadelphia, PA. Dr. Elliott completed his Emergency Medicine residency at University of Michigan in Ann Arbor, MI.
